Lookout Landing Phase III Homeowners Association Satellite Dish or Exterior Antenna Guidelines

Exhibit F, Section 3 discusses antenna guidelines; however, FCC guidelines are enforced as required by federal law.

- 1. Installation Preferred Locations:
 - a. Antennas and dishes should be installed at a location not visible from the street.
 - b. Should not be higher than absolutely necessary for reception of quality signal.
 - c. Should be placed in the least obtrusive and least visible place providing reception quality.
- 2. If the satellite dish or antenna is mounted on the house, the brackets and cables must be painted to blend into their background, usually the house body color.
- 3. Present and future aesthetic value of the community must be considered when installing the satellite dish.
- 4. Homeowners are responsible for the maintenance and repair of antennas. Antennas must not be allowed to fall into disrepair or become safety hazards.
- 5. The homeowner should work with the dish vendor to explore all installation options to receive an adequate signal while ensuring the dish is not visible when viewed from the street. This includes mounting on the back of the roof, fireplace chase, back wall, side wall hidden by a fence, or ground mounted on a post in the back yard.
- 6. Consult the Declarations for additional rules and restrictions.

Notice of Installation

Prior to OR upon completion of installation of a satellite dish or exterior antenna the homeowner must supply the following:

- 1. Notice of Installation Form
- 2. Statement and evidence from installer if an acceptable quality signal could not be received in the installation preferred locations.

Failure to provide the documentation will result in commencement of the enforcement and fine policy.
